The Veteran’s Healing Farm will be hosting their first veteran boot camp on beekeeping September 14 – 16. The boot camp is in collaboration with Doc’s Healing Hives and was made possible through funding from the Newman’s Own Foundation. This is a three day intensive course on beekeeping. Meals, bee equipment, hive boxes, honey bees and housing are all included. Beekeeping as a hobby is therapeutic, helps hard-working pollinators thrive, and is also a means of helping plants and ecosystems grow strong. Our club will be assisting in this effort by sponsoring breakfast from Joey’s Bagels on Saturday morning.

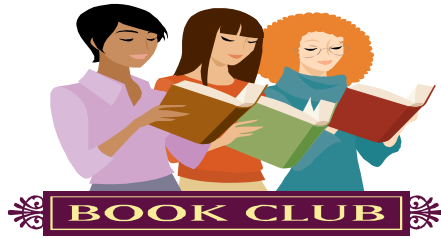

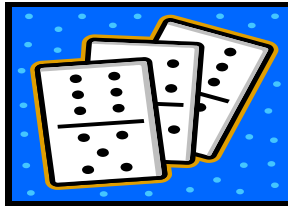

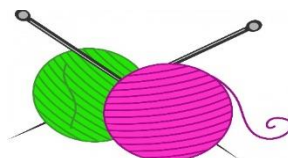
